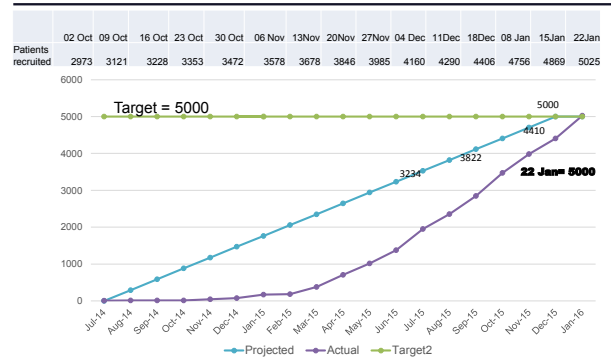
Updates to Clinpal are being planned to include new fields to capture additional data. These are currently being finalised with the steering committee. Further information will be circulated in the next newsletter.

- **Forthcoming Investigators Meetings** in the planning phase are:

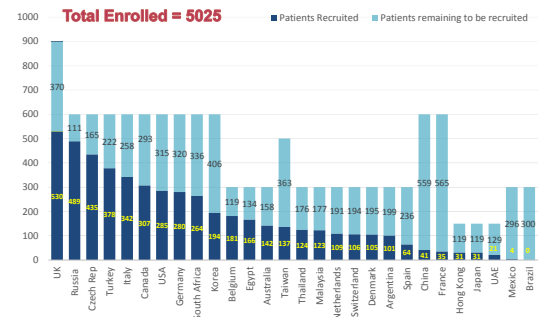

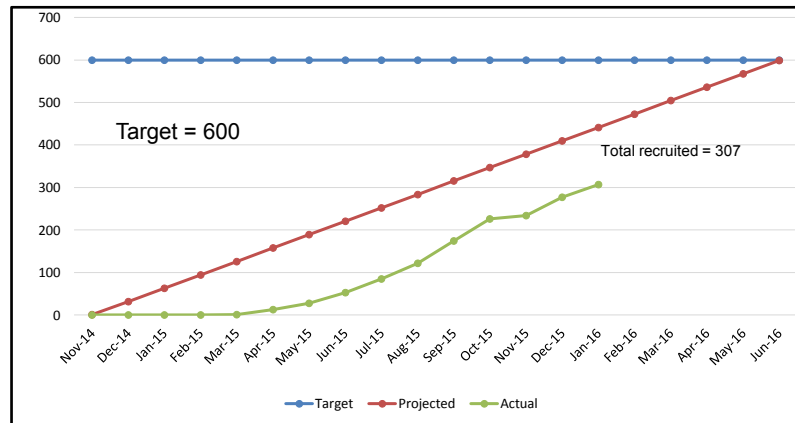
Global Enrolment : By Country (Actual and Target Recruitment)
